WorkBC Centres offer individualized employment services and support to help you get a job including:

- Individualized employment counselling & support from expert staff
- Job search support, access to local job opportunities & connections to employers
- Workshops to help you plan and prepare for a job
- Help with resume and interview preparation
- Wage subsidy job placements and skills training
- Clinical counselling to support employment readiness
- Foreign credentialing and language interpretation services
- Financial supports to help you participate in services and to start a job including dependent care, transportation, essential work clothing/supplies and more
- Individuals participating in WorkBC services are eligible for a free laptop
