Our [Testimonial Consent and Release](#) form gives the Ministry of Post-Secondary Education and Future Skills permission to share success stories and **allows people to choose how they would like to be identified**, including the option to remain anonymous.

We love photos and videos! Please be sure to provide signed consent forms for every person who appears in a photos or video.

Stories submitted without consent forms will be reviewed by program staff, but won't be shared publicly.

Tools for gathering success stories

We count on you to help gather and submit success stories related to your project.

To get a well-rounded story of your project's success, we encourage you to provide success stories from **1participants**, **2employers**, and from **3your own perspective as the agreement holder**.

To help you gather success stories, we've provided the following tools:

- **Fillable success story forms** with guiding questions for [participants](#), [employers](#), and [agreement holders](#).
- **[Template emails](#)** for requesting success stories from participants and employers.
- **[Testimonial Consent and Release form](#)**, which must be signed for success stories to be shared publicly.

How it works:

1. After training concludes, **request success stories and consent forms** from participants and employers.
2. **Fill out your own success story and consent form** as the agreement holder.
3. **Upload all success stories, images/videos and signed consent forms** to the [Skills Training Grant](#) system. If you no longer have access to the system, email the materials to CWRG@gov.bc.ca.
